



CODE OF ETHICS

As a member of the Weighing Industry Association of Australia, I will, to the best of my ability, abide by the Association Code of Ethics as it is here set forth:

1. Keep uppermost in mind the fundamental importance of the weighing instrument to our way of life.
2. Endeavor to impress upon all the vitally significant part that weighing instruments play in providing the most important measurement of most of the World's mediums of exchange, including real goods and monies.
3. Diligently promote the use of weighing instruments as the most precise means of measuring mass or weight.
4. Conduct myself according to the highest standards of professional ethics regarding the representation of, and charges for, goods or services rendered, and thereby reflect credit on my Association and the weighing industry.
5. Always strive diligently to render services in keeping with the best practice of proper weights and measures interpretations.
6. Take an active interest in existing laws and regulations, in proposed legislation pertaining thereto, and aid in procuring such laws and regulations as are in the best interests of the general public.
7. Keep abreast of new developments in weighing equipment and methods, to encourage the procurement of, and to recommend the proper usage for, equipment that will effect greater precision and efficiency in weight measurements.
8. Support the Weighing Industry Association of Australia, its policies, and programs, and participate in Association activities for the mutual benefit of all its members and the clients that it serves.
9. Endeavor to earn, and to carefully guard, a reputation of good moral character, good citizenship, and common honesty, and to support and promote all the uplifting influences of the community.
10. Strive to raise the standards of efficiency of myself and my associates, and to elevate our professional standing to a position in keeping with the responsibilities of the weighing industry.
